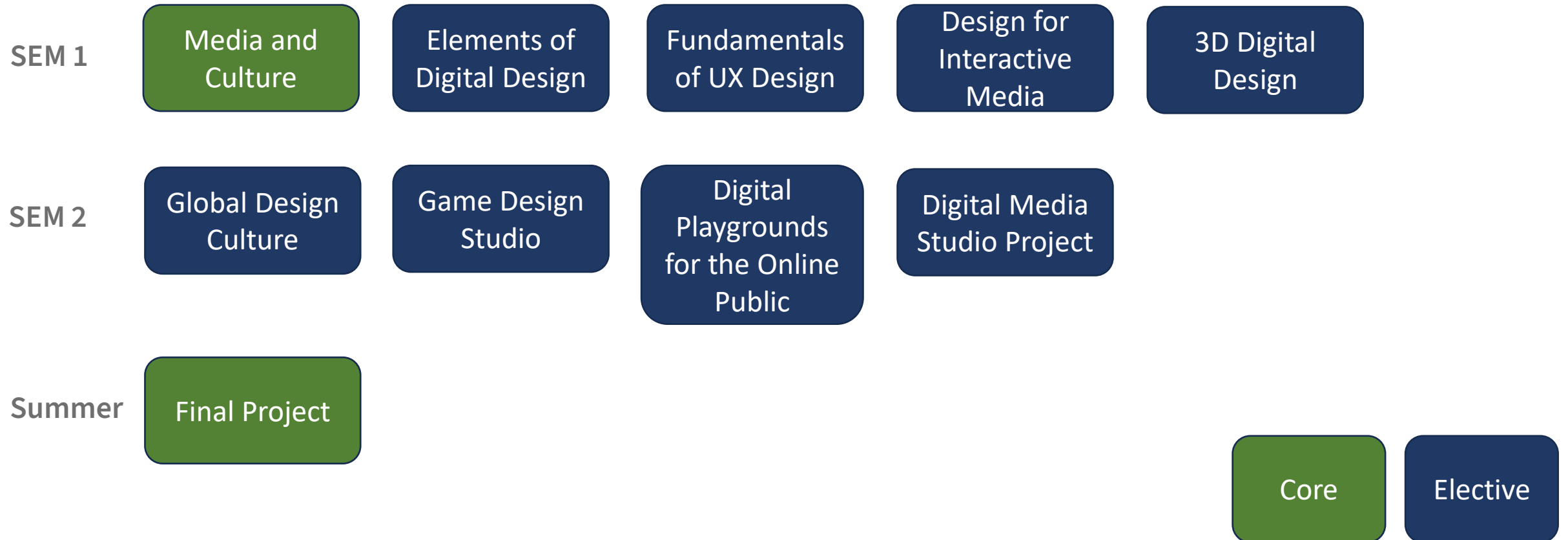


Academic journey
