- MScR: 1 year/2 years; PhD: 3 years/6 years
- Start dates: 1 October (or 1 January, but please check)



A typical year

- Induction (4 sessions)
- No compulsory courses
- School-wide seminars and training courses
- Student-led social activities
- Research Hubs
- Annual review



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Entry requirements

- Requirements:
 - (1) UG – 2:1 degree, or its equivalent
 - (2) PG – 60%+ at Masters AND 60%+ in the dissertation element of the Masters degree
 - (3) English language proficiency
- IELTS Academic: total 7.0 with at least 6.5 in each component.
- TOEFL-iBT (including Home Edition): total 100 with at least 23 in each component. We do not accept TOEFL MyBest Score to meet our English language requirements.
- C1 Advanced (CAE) / C2 Proficiency (CPE): total 185 with at least 176 in each component.
- Trinity ISE: ISE III with passes in all four components.
- PTE Academic: total 70 with at least 62 in each component.
- Your English language qualification must be no more than three and a half years old from the start date of the programme you are applying to study.
- Degrees taught and assessed in English
