# Getting started

## Open Day venues

## Travel between campuses

Remember to factor in travel time when planning your day. You can use our free Open Day shuttle bus service to travel between our Central campus (Buccleuch Place) and King's Buildings campus. You must pre-book for our Medicine and Veterinary Medicine visit shuttle buses. More details are on page 11.

## Check in

Check in using the 'self check in' button in your online ticket. You can also check in - at any time - at one of our Helpdesks using the ticket/QR code in your emails. If you have not booked to attend, please register at a Helpdesk. You may also need to check in for individual talks and tours, so keep your email and QR code handy!

## Accompanying guests

Some activities will be very busy. If there is limited space, we will prioritise prospective students.

Your booking for a talk, taster session or tour ensures that the student associated with the booking will be able to attend, however guests may not always be able to accompany them. We will allocate any remaining spaces on a first come, first served basis, with priority for prospective students.

# Activities

What to expect from some of our main Open Day activities. Full listings are on pages 4 - 9.

## Subject and service talks

These talks provide an introduction to our subject areas and other aspects of studying with us, including accommodation, study abroad, sport and student life. Most talks will last 30 minutes.

## Information desks

Available for our subject areas and key services from 10am – 4pm. Our staff are available to speak to you about our subject areas and courses (pages 5 – 9), as well as fees, funding, study abroad, careers, support, extracurricular activities and more (page 4).

## Admissions

Our admissions staff are available at information desks between 10am – 4pm to provide one-to-one, tailored advice on applying to the University (see page 5). You should ask any admissions questions here rather than at subject information desks, unless otherwise stated.

Admissions talks provide general information about admission to a particular College, while the admissions information desks offer you the opportunity to find out detailed entry requirements for your chosen programme and discuss your circumstances.

## Taster lectures

Available in a range of subjects, these sample lectures will give you an insight into what studying at Edinburgh might be like. While the lectures are presented by academics from specific subject areas, they may be of general interest to a wider audience.

## Language taster sessions

Our School of Literatures, Languages and Cultures is running beginners' language taster sessions, each covering a language from Europe, East Asia or the Middle East which you may not have had a chance to try before. To give you an authentic experience of small group learning, numbers are very limited so advance booking is required. View more details and book using the ticket link in your event emails.

## Fees and funding

Staff at our Fees & Student Support, and Scholarships & Student Funding information desks in McEwan Hall can provide information about funding opportunities, tuition fees, scholarships, bursaries and financial assistance.

The Student Awards Agency Scotland (SAAS) are also available in McEwan Hall to speak to about the financial support they provide to students from Scotland.

## Accommodation

Find out about our student accommodation options and 'accommodation guarantee' from the staff at the accommodation information desks as well as multiple talks throughout the day. A selection of accommodation is open to tour at Pollock Halls, though please note that only a few example rooms will be available to view (page 4).

## Tours and facilities

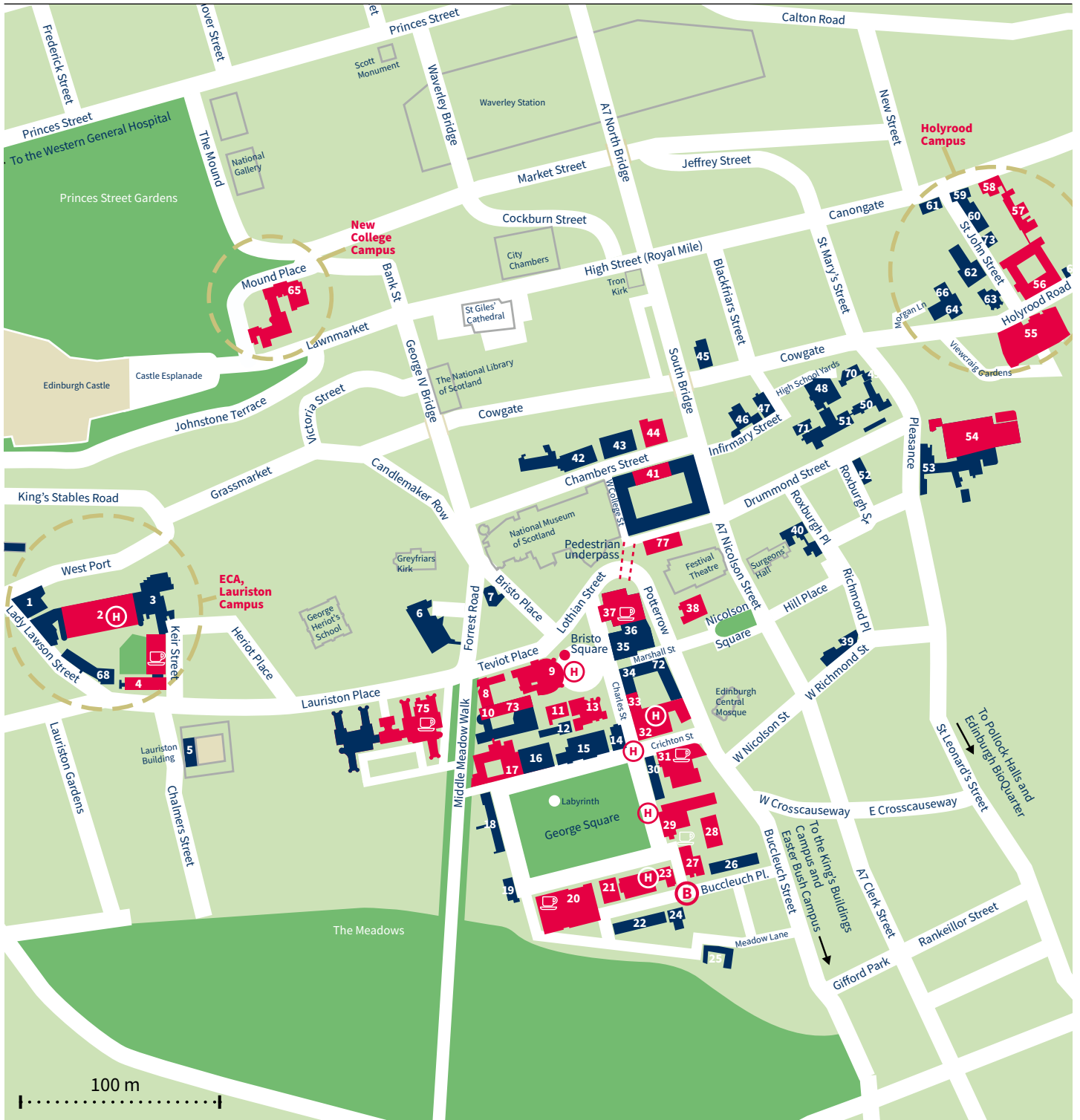

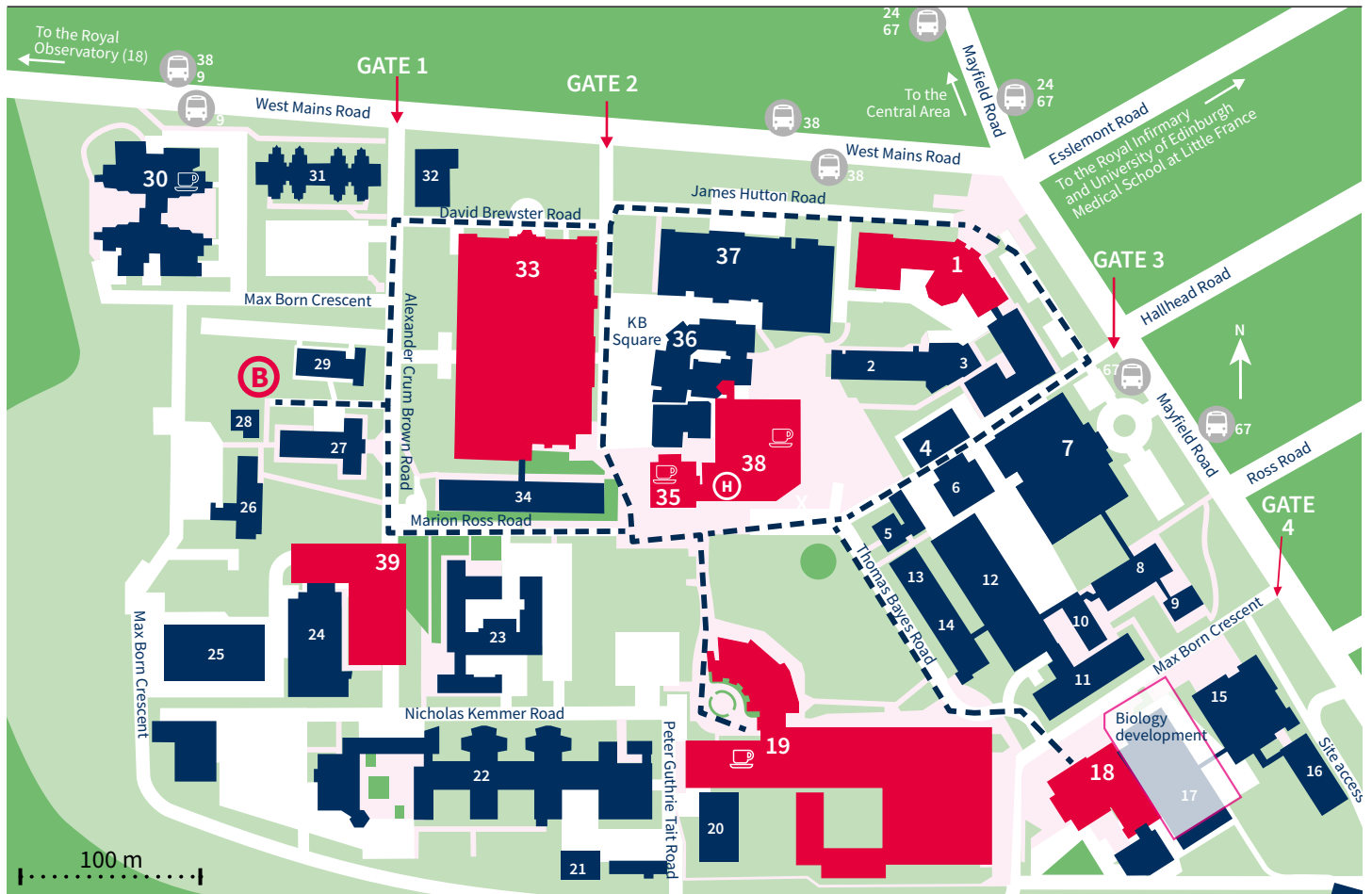
